

Empowered Dreams: Through your contributions, we provided life-changing scholarships to **25 deserving students in 2024.**

Academic Excellence: HCF students boast an impressive **3.63 Average Collegiate GPA.**

This year, a remarkable **100% of participants** maintained a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Community Service Hours: HCF students completed over **1,500 community service hours** this year, making a meaningful impact in our community.

Graduation Milestones: A total of **59 students** successfully graduated from their hospitality or culinary arts programs within four years. Notably, we have risen this number to **83% of HCF students have graduated in four years** during the past decade. A remarkable contrast to the CCSD's current rate is 18%


